

Narvik Campaign Shield Navy Gold Version in Zinc Unknown Maker

Description

The Narvik Arm Shield was the 1st Campaign Shield to be instituted by Adolf Hitler on 19th August 1940. This shield was authorized for all members of the Army Navy and Air Force who took part in the campaign around Narvik in Norway between 9th April 1940 – 9th June 1940. The Navy Version was normally mounted on a Navy Blue backing Cloth. It came in Metallic / Zinc and Silver / Gold versions.
