


**S.A. Sports Badge in Bronze**  
**BERG & NOLTE A.G., EIGENTUM D.S.A.SPORTABZEICHEN HAUPTSTELLE - LUDENSCHIED**  
**Serial Number "829687"**

### Description

The SA-Sport Badge was instituted on November 28, 1933. Testing for the award was broken down into three main groups (physical fitness, military defence and field exercises), which were in turn broken down into subdivisions. Men under the age of 35 who successfully passed the test requirements during a twelve month period received a **Bronze** colored badge.

### Remarks

This particular maker has an interesting double indentation on the pin just above the catch on most of their SA Badges. This badge is stamped with Serial Number "829687" on it's reverse, indicating it was manufactured before September 1939.
