

## Reich Party Day Badge 1933 (Reichsparteitagabzeichen) C. BALMBERGER Solid Version

### Description

This is the most commonly encountered version of the day badge or “tinnie” worn to commemorate the first official Nazi Party Rally in Nürnberg, held in September 1933. The badge is die-stamped from solid sheet bronze. The pin mount of this example is marked C. BALMBERGER NÜRNBERG. The more common pin attachment is by soldering, with no maker mark. A hollow stamped bronze version and silver metal solid version are also known.
