

## NAVAL HIGH SEAS FLEET WAR BADGE (1941) (Flotten – Kriegsabzeichen) Schwerin

### Description

Instituted on April 30, 1941, the badge was intended to recognize the sea struggle against England. The badge was to be worn by crew members of battleships and cruisers. The badge was to be worn on the lower left breast. The forward sailing ship and sea are grey, and are surrounded by a gilt wreath and national eagle. The reverse of the badge is concave.

### Remarks

Certainly, one of the most popular Third Reich KM awards. Examples can be found with five full bridge windows, or with the 5<sup>th</sup> window shallow struck. This flaw can be attributed to a worn die.
