


German Cross in Gold

Description

The German Cross was instituted on 28. September 1941 in two classes: Gold and Silver. The German Cross is a pin back award and was worn below the right breast pocket of the uniform.

Height	63.18 mm	Weight	51.9 g	Type/Pattern	unmarked
Width	63.38 mm	Material	Non-magnetic		

Remarks: Five rivets, the center one is bigger and domed. If marked, number "2" on outside of pin. Numeral "9" in date shows the 'flaw'. Catch with round stock soldered directly to plate also known. Hinge on plate soldered into recess.
