


1939 Spange to the 1914 Iron Cross First Class "Unmarked"

Description

The Spange to the Iron Cross 1st Class 1914 was instituted on September 1st, 1939. The criteria of earning this medal was having previously been awarded the Iron Cross 1st Class from World War 1. The spange was worn on the left breast pocket just above the 1914 Iron Cross 1st Class.

Remarks

This example by B.H. Mayer is most often found unmarked. The case has the outline of the spange on the top. The outer cardboard carton is rare, and not often found with the rest of the spange package.
