

1939 Spange to the 1914 Iron Cross Second Class

“L/11”

Description

The Spange to the Iron Cross 2nd Class measured approximately 30 mm height by 30 mm width. The clasp was worn on a piece of 1914-type ribbon (black-white-black-white-black) in the second buttonhole of the uniform jacket.

Remarks: The featured Spange is made of zinc. Note the over-filed beak, often seen on Deumers. The shorter top wing feather is a standard characteristic of Spangen by this maker.
