

## Spanish Cross in Silver with Swords Unknown maker

### Description

This silver cross of an unknown company is showing the silver content mark "900", stamped on the reverse, with high figures. This cross was made in solid silver and then a silver wash applied. I think it is an awarded cross. The attachment system, hinge and pin, are typical to this unknown maker, also the large swords grips. Note the 3 arms are cut-out in each eagle swastika.

The Spanish Cross (Spanienkreuz) was instituted on April, 14th 1935 by A. Hitler (14.4.1939, RGBI. IS.1939, 1360). The silver class was awarded 8304 times during the main Legion Condor return parades in Hamburg and Döberitz.
