

## S.A. Sports Badge in Gold W.REDO, EIGENTUM D, OBERSTE, S.A.-FUHRUNG, SAARLAUTERN

### Description

The SA-Sport Badge was instituted on November 28, 1933. Testing for the award was broken down into three main groups (physical fitness, military defence and field exercises), which were in turn broken down into subdivisions. Men who had been awarded the silver badge, and continued to pass the tests annually for an additional six years, or men over 40 who passed the tests during a twelve-month period received the badge finished in a **Gold** color.

This example is a striking specimen with the Gold finish still intact. This particular badge is devoid of any Serial Number on its reverse, indicating it was manufactured after September 1939.
