

Reich Party Day Badge 1938 (Reichsparteitagabzeichen) FOERSTER & BARTH PFORZHEIM

Description

This is day badge or "tinnie" worn to commemorate the 1938 official Nazi Party Rally in Nürnberg. The badge is die-stamped from aluminum. The pin of this example is crimped to the back of the badge. The maker's mark is in relief. The back of the badge also has the RZM control mark in relief, along with the badge contract code for Foerster & Barth (M9/7). The initials RK in relief on the front of the badge represent the designer, Richard Klein. Other examples are known with silver-color finish on the front. A Cupal (copper-clad aluminium) version is also known.
