

Reich Party Day Badge 1939 (Reichsparteitagabzeichen) GUSTAV BREHMER MARKNEUKIRCHEN

Description

This is day badge or "tinnie" designed for the 1939 official Nazi Party Rally in Nürnberg. The 1939 Reichsparteitag event was cancelled because the German invasion of Poland started WWII before the event could be held. The badge is die-stamped from aluminum. The pin of this example is crimped to the back of the badge. The maker's mark is in relief. The back of the badge also has the RZM control mark in relief, along with the badge contract code for Brehmer (M9/4). The initials RK in relief on the front of the badge represent the designer, Richard Klein. Other examples are known with silver or dark gray color finishes on the front.
